





#### **North American Division Membership -- 2011-2016**





Age: 23% under 18 years old


32% between 18-30 years old








#### **Union Transfers 2011-2015**






### Rates of Net Growth by Union





# Total Membership 1965 vs. Total Membership 2016






#### Membership Per Conference with 200-5,000 Members





### Membership Per Conference (5,000-10,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)






### Membership per Conference (10,000-15,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)








## Membership per Conference (15,000-20,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)





























# Membership per Conference (55,000-60,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)





## Membership per Conference (60,000-65,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)







## Membership per Conference (65,000-70,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)











## Christians are the largest religious group in 2015

#### Number of people in 2015, in billions





Estimated percent change in population size, 2015-2060




