






NAD Financial Statement Operating 2011 - 2015







NAD Financial Statement Operating 2011 – 2015 (Total, Operating, & Plant)








North American Division Tithe For Past 10 Years






North American Division Tithe Gain (Loss) for 10 Years in Dollars






Worldwide Tithe - 2003 through 2014 in Millions








North American Division Missions For Past 10 Years






North American Division Tithe Tithe Gain (Loss) for 10 Years in Percent's






Worldwide Mission Offering 2003 through 2014 in Millions




2015 Gross Tithe used for the 2017 Tithe Budget




2016 Payroll Assumptions Remuneration Factor


2017 Budgeted NAD Use of Tithe Funds:


