Need for Innovation

SDAs are declining as % of NAD population

Our growth does not keep up with population growth

Our impact is decreasing each year

Fewer people know us each year

Our soul winning has fallen behind territory's needs

• 1/2 in NAD: Millennial or GenZ

• 7-13 hrs per day online

• 1/3 of this population a "none"

• 1/4 of total population "nones"

Half our territory exists online

GenZ 25% of population

Largest generation in history

• 1/4 say they "live online"

• 8% of this group has religious role model

• 48-49% of 18-24 yr olds & all Millennials do NOT identify as 100% heterosexual

Post-Christian era harder to evangelize

 Christian to Adventist vs. "None" to Adventist (which is harder?)

 Post-Christian: 1/4-1/3 of entire NAD population = "none"

• 1/2 ministry territory is under 40

• 1/2 ministry territory lives online

 We have to reach them where they are, not where we want them to be
