

North American Division Membership vs. World Membership 2019





2019 Total Gains/Total Losses by Union
















Church Reporting Attendance (40%)











COVID-19 ONLINE CHURCH ATTENDANCE AMONG PRACTICING CHRISTIANS







COVID-19 ONLINE CHURCH ATTENDANCE, BY GENERATION








